DUR BOARD MEMBERS

Nevada Medicaid is currently recruiting actively practicing, licensed physicians and pharmacists to become members of the Drug Use Review (DUR) Board.

Members are appointed by the State Director of Health and Human Services.

The primary goal of drug utilization review is to enhance and improve the quality of pharmaceutical care and patient outcomes by encouraging optimal drug use.

Members have knowledge and expertise in clinically appropriate prescribing/dispensing/monitoring of outpatient drugs, evaluation and intervention, and medical quality assurance.

DUTIES

- Participate in quarterly public meetings
- Establish prior authorization and quantity limits to certain drugs/drug classes based on utilization data, experience, and testimony presented.
- Perform retrospective evaluation of interventions and prospective drug review.
