According to the Partnership to Fight Chronic Disease, in 2015 1.7 million Nevadans had at least one chronic disease and 693,000 had two or more chronic diseases. The projected overall cost of chronic disease in years 2016-2030 in Nevada is \$401 billion dollars. Many minority groups have higher prevalence rates for heart disease, cancer, diabetes and stroke leading to increased rates of disability and death.
