Topic: Assembly Bill 147 – State Law Allows Physician Assistants and Advanced Practice

Registered Nurses (APRNs) to order home health care for a patient.

To: Home Health Care Agencies

The purpose of this bulletin is to notify the affected health care providers and the public of recently adopted statutes.

Assembly Bill 147 of the 2019 legislative session amends NRS 630.271 to allow a physician assistant licensed pursuant to NRS Chapter 630 and amends NRS 632.237 to allow an advanced practice registered nurse licensed pursuant to NRS Chapter 632 to order home health care for a patient. This law took effect July 1, 2019.

If your home health agency is certified by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) please note the following Codes of Federal Regulations (CFR) still apply to your agency:

- CFR §484.60(b)(1) Drugs, services, and treatments are administered only as ordered by a physician.
- CFR §484.60(a)(1) Each patient must receive the home health services that are
 written in an individualized plan of care that identifies patient-specific measurable
 outcomes and goals, and which is established, periodically reviewed, and signed by a
 doctor-of-medicine, osteopathy, or podiatry acting within the scope of his or her state
 license, certification, or registration. If a physician refers a patient under a plan of care
 that cannot be completed until after an evaluation visit, the physician is consulted to
 approve additions or modifications to the original plan.
- CFR §484.60(d)(1) Assure communication with all physicians involved in the plan of care.
